

The Holy Spirit's Interpretation of Acts

NTI Acts, Chapter 1

📖(v 1 – 11)¹The power of all truth is within you. ²The story of Jesus is helpful to you as a guide, a tool, and a symbol, but the answer for you lies not in his story. ³If it had, he would have stayed on earth to provide the answer to you. ⁴But Jesus left your realm and returned to the Father, that you may be freed to find your answer within yourself.

⁵The Holy Spirit, which seemed to be given to the apostles when Jesus ascended from the world, was not passed on to them at this time. ⁶Only God can give the gift of the Holy Spirit, and God has given this gift to everyone. ⁷The gift has always been in the world, even before Jesus. ⁸This gift has always guided you. ⁹But as long as you continue to look outside of yourself for answers and satisfaction, you are unaware of this gift.

¹⁰When Jesus ascended and promised the baptism of the Holy Spirit, he only pointed the apostles to seek where the Holy Spirit already was. ¹¹In this way, they learned not to look outside for teaching and guidance, but to clearly look within.

¹²This is My lesson to you. ¹³I am here to help for a time, but My purpose is to teach you to look and listen within. ¹⁴For always, your guidance must come from there, because always, the answer is there.

(v 12 – 26)¹The first step to listening within for the guidance of the Holy Spirit is prayer. ²But to hear Him truly, you must pray in a way that opens to Him. ³Prayer is not a time of asking for what you want. ⁴Prayer is a time of putting aside that which you want and opening to *any guidance* that He would give. ⁵Prayer is a time of gratitude for His love and wisdom. ⁶Prayer is a time of surrender because you seek nothing less than His love, wisdom and guidance for you.

⁷Therefore, pray in this way:

⁸Father, I do not know what is best for me now, in this time and this place, that I may be led back to You. ⁹Because I cannot see the path I am ready to walk, take my hand and send me your Voice to guide me. ¹⁰I shall go where it asks me to go, and I shall do as it asks me to do in joy and peace and certainty.

¹¹The second step to listening for guidance is this:

¹²You must trust.

¹³You must not only trust the Voice and the guidance you receive; you must also trust yourself. ¹⁴For the guidance comes from you through your knowing that is beyond conscious choice. ¹⁵To doubt yourself is to doubt your guidance. ¹⁶So you must trust yourself and trust what comes.

NTI Acts, Chapter 2

(v 1 – 13)¹The Holy Spirit knows the way. ²The Holy Spirit sees the whole plan, not only your part in it. ³Therefore, you must trust all that the Holy Spirit asks you to do, even if what is asked does not seem to be for you. ⁴For the Holy Spirit does not look at the world and see separated sons of God, each in need of separate plans of salvation. ⁵The Holy Spirit sees one Son and one plan. ⁶And so, what He gives to you is not for you alone. ⁷To learn this is so, you must do as He asks and trust Him.

(v 14 – 21)¹The paths given may seem to be individualized and the experiences may seem personal, but I assure you that they are not. ²Everything that is given by the Holy Spirit is given for all and to all, as the Holy Spirit does not see separate parts, but only one. ³When you hear stories of your brother's and your sister's experience with the Holy Spirit, rejoice and know that experience was also given for you. ⁴In this way, you demonstrate trust. ⁵Through the demonstration of trust, trust shall grow within you, that you may hear and see more.

(v 22 – 35)¹There will be symbols and there will be symbols of symbols, but always it is true that only the truth is true. ²Therefore, do not be caught up in your symbols. ³Do not identify with them, fight for them or argue with your brother about the symbols you choose to love. ⁴In this way, the symbol becomes but another idol that blinds you to the truth. ⁵Remember that Jesus left the earth so you would not make an idol of him, but that you would learn from him the way of truth.

(v 36)¹Therefore, know and remember this, because this is what Jesus taught:

*²There is no death,
and the answer that you seek
is already here within you.*


(v 37 – 41)¹Peter was a teacher, but when he spoke, the Holy Spirit spoke through him. ²And when the people listened, the Holy Spirit listened for them, pointing to the words they were to hear.

³Do not be confused by all that you see and hear and experience within the world. ⁴It does not need to take a specific form to be used by the Holy Spirit for your teaching and your guidance. ⁵Since He is the overseer of all things, all things can be used by Him for your benefit.

⁶I will teach you how to listen to Him in all situations and at all times. ⁷Listen to Me, and be glad!

(v 42 – 47)¹Your joy shall increase as you listen to the Voice of the Holy Spirit, for He shall lead you to see no value where there is none and to know the love that is already within your Heart. ²This love, which is the source of all joy, is not a special love that includes some, but not all. ³It is an encompassing love, from which joy comes bursting forth from your Heart into the world that you see.

NTI Acts, Chapter 3

 (v 1 – 10)¹Peter was a teacher who gave what he had, and what he gave came to him from the Holy Spirit. ²It was through giving it that Peter learned he had it to give, for he could not give it if it was not already his.

³The miracles that Peter witnessed, he witnessed for himself within his own mind. ⁴And these miracles were extended to others, that they too may begin to learn who they are. ⁵This is what made Peter a great teacher. ⁶He shared all that he had, recognizing that it was for all. ⁷And through this practice, Peter came to see that all were not separate, but they were one.

(v 11 – 26)¹The ego is the thought within the mind that separates. ²The ego says that what is true is not true, and what is not, is the truth. ³But the ego is not the truth, and so its words cannot be believed.

⁴You experience the ego as a stream of thoughts within the mind that seem to interpret, counsel, identify, judge and spring forth as ideas. ⁵In themselves, these thoughts seem to be nothing to you, although you listen to them and act on all that they say. ⁶These thoughts rule your mind and your interpretation of the world, because you believe what they say. ⁷Yet, they are based on a foundation of separateness, which is not what is true. ⁸And so what is true is not in what they say.

⁹To listen to these thoughts and believe them is ignorance, for you are listening to what is not true, but believing what you hear. ¹⁰Any action you take based on these thoughts is ignorant action, for it is action based on untruth in an unreal world.

¹¹Ignorance is not guilt. ¹²It is a call for knowledge. ¹³It is the Holy Spirit that leads you through corrected perception to the right-knowledge that you seek. ¹⁴Right-knowledge is true knowledge, and true knowledge is the knowledge of truth.

¹⁵Do not worry about the mistakes you have made. ¹⁶They are based on ignorance, which is illusion and affects only that which is not reality. ¹⁷Be happy that you have been mistaken! ¹⁸Be joyous that there is another way to see! ¹⁹This is what it means to repent. ²⁰To repent is to choose again. ²¹To repent is to decide to turn from the ways of ignorance and turn to the Voice of Knowledge. ²²This is a joyous decision, for this is the decision that changes all things. ²³This decision that you have made is a decision to listen to another Voice. ²⁴It is the decision to let go of the thoughts you have listened to until now and to listen to another Voice, the one that comes from God. ²⁵This decision is a decision to change the habits you have had until now. ²⁶It is a decision to see yourself through new eyes, eyes that are based on a foundation of truth.

²⁷This is why I am here. ²⁸I am here to help you make this change from believing in the false to listening to the Voice of what is true. ²⁹This is the decision of your joy. ³⁰This is your path. ³¹This is your way. ³²And I will help you, until you do not need this help anymore.

NTI Acts, Chapter 4

📖(v 1 – 22)¹I have told you before that you will be tempted to deny your guidance. ²And I have told you where this temptation will come from. ³It is resistance born of a sense of unworthiness. ⁴I have also told you where this sense of unworthiness comes from. ⁵It is born of guilt, born of the belief that you have stolen yourself from God.

⁶Here lies another contradiction that you must look at slowly and carefully:

⁷You believe you have stolen yourself from God. ⁸That is to say, you believe you have made yourself separate from God's Will. ⁹You believe it is your choice to follow God's Will *or* your own, and you feel guilty for this choice, because you believe it is a sin to have made a will that is separate from God's.

¹⁰Your guilt, born of the choice to have a separate will, leaves you feeling unworthy of God's Will. ¹¹And so, out of your guilt and sense of unworthiness, you deny God's Will by not hearing it, or by hearing it, but by not believing you are deserving to follow it.

¹²There are several things you must look at here. ¹³First, you *do* have the desire to know and follow God's Will. ¹⁴Hold that up as a beacon. ¹⁵That is your willingness. ¹⁶Let it guide you to your true Heart's desire.

¹⁷Secondly, the feeling that seems to be an obstacle to knowing and following God's Will is the belief that you are unworthy of God's Will. ¹⁸This is like a crafty trick. ¹⁹It is a loop that keeps you trapped within an illusion of yourself.

²⁰You think you are guilty because you want to serve a will other than God's,

and

²¹Your true desire is to serve God's Will, but your sense of unworthiness is an obstacle to that desire.

²²Do you see the loop in which you are snared? ²³Can you see how your own belief in your guilt and unworthiness seems to lead you onto the path of increased guilt and additional unworthiness?

²⁴This is why I have come, to help you look at the upside-down reasoning within the mind that keeps you feeling trapped. ²⁵And also to help you see that you are *not trapped*, because you can lay down this reasoning that makes no sense. ²⁶When you lay it down and put it aside, you are free to know the reasoning of the Holy Spirit, which is right-reasoning and is joy.

²⁷Remember this story of Peter and John as a symbol to help you hold onto your willingness. ²⁸Know that as they listened to pleas to lay down their purpose, there were doubts in their minds that seemed to echo the reasoning of the pleas. ²⁹They were simple men, and they seemed to be taking on the history of the world with the new message that they taught. ³⁰But know also that they did not listen to their doubts, their fears or their own sense of unworthiness. ³¹They trusted their message as the message of the Holy Spirit and the one Will of God. ³²In following this trust, they gave themselves permission to do God's Will, which was their Heart's only true desire.

³³Remember this symbol. ³⁴You *are* worthy of God's Will for you. ³⁵You are worthy of the Voice for God and all that it will share with you. ³⁶When doubt enters your mind, born of unworthiness and guilt, lay it aside. ³⁷It is the loop you do not want. ³⁸It is the loop that hides the truth from you.

(v 23 – 31)¹I have also told you not to be confused by what you hear, see and experience within the world. ²Everything is applicable to the purpose the Holy Spirit has set forth. ³Everything can be used for the salvation of God's one Holy Son.

⁴When the form of what you see or hear or experience confuses you, remember to pray to Me. ⁵Remember that what you look upon confuses you only because you believe in separate wills. ⁶If you knew that there was only one Will, you could not be confused.

⁷Remember also that whenever you look at the world with the ego's upside-down reasoning, you cannot see clearly. ⁸Be willing to deny what you see, and trust that there must be another way to understand the situation you look upon.

⁹Pray, then, in this way:

¹⁰Oh Father, I come to you now in humility and gratitude. ¹¹I am humble, because I realize that I do not know how to see. ¹²I cannot see the Holy Spirit's plan, and so I do not know what I look upon. ¹³But I also come in gratitude, because I trust that the Holy Spirit does know, and the plan is safe with Him as the overseer of all things. ¹⁴Amen.

¹⁵Then give yourself to your Father's Will, offering that you may be used for the purpose of healing, without the desire to judge. ¹⁶This is to lay yourself aside and to do your part in your Father's plan. ¹⁷This is God's Will for you. ¹⁸This is how you can be useful to the whole.


(v 32 – 37)¹To give of yourself is to give as you are asked to give without judgment. ²Whenever you notice guilt within your mind, you have judged, and so you are not listening with full desire to only be useful. ³You are also asking that you may decide what is right and what is wrong, which means that you are asking that you may exercise a will of your own.

⁴Do not let this realization upset you. ⁵Indeed, you may laugh when you find it within yourself. ⁶It is nothing more than another ploy of the desire to hide your true desire from you. ⁷It is another loop that leads you nowhere. ⁸It is another opportunity to remind yourself that you do not know the plan, and therefore, you cannot judge.

⁹Be happy. ¹⁰You are only asked to do what you are asked to do. ¹¹If you do all that you are asked, you have done enough. ¹²There is nothing more to give, having given everything that you have been asked to give.

¹³Give in joy, knowing it is your true Will to give. ¹⁴Let go of guilt, knowing it is just the illusion of an illusory will. ¹⁵For any will that seems separate from God's Will must be an illusion, for you *do know* that your true Will is always the same as His.

NTI Acts, Chapter 5

 (v 1 – 11)¹This story is symbolic and is not to be taken literally. ²This story is a picture of the guilt that you have claimed and projected onto the world. ³This story has no meaning, except that it is untrue. ⁴And it is important that you see it as untrue *for you* also.

⁵An obstacle to hearing the Holy Spirit is your own sense of guilt and unworthiness. ⁶This story demonstrates just how guilty you believe you are. ⁷Notice that Ananias and his wife dropped dead from their guilt. ⁸Imagine the magnitude of the guilt that seemed to be within them. ⁹But what crime did this couple commit? ¹⁰They sold land that belonged to them and gave a portion of the money that they made to the apostles of their own free will. ¹¹Could this be called a crime? ¹²Even within your world, this could not be called a crime. ¹³To give in this way is generosity. ¹⁴So, what was their crime?

¹⁵This story seems to say that the crime this couple committed is the crime of not being honest with God; it is the crime of hiding something from God; it is the crime of keeping something for yourself. ¹⁶It is *this* we must look at, because it is this you think

you have done. ¹⁷It is this for which you feel guilty, and it is this guilt that seems to bring on your death.

¹⁸We will talk about this guilt slowly and carefully, that you may look at this belief deeply and with right-reason, so you may choose to release a belief that you do not need to keep.

¹⁹First, we must discuss what God is. ²⁰I have told you that God is Life, and that Life is eternal. ²¹Since you accept that God is eternal and God gives life, this may not be difficult for you to accept. ²²So let's take this thought another step.

²³*God is Life,
and you live,
so Life must be within you.*

²⁴*This means that God is within you also.*

²⁵At this point, you may feel a temptation to pull away from My logic, but please do not pull away just yet. ²⁶Let's examine why you want to pull away and look at that closely.

²⁷God is within you. ²⁸This is a thought that you are tempted to reject. ²⁹The reason you want to reject this thought is because you believe that God is good, but you are guilty. ³⁰Therefore, you determine that God cannot be in you, and you must be separate from God. ³¹If God is Life, which you have accepted, and you are separate from God, then it must be that you are separate from Life. ³²And that is death. ³³That is why death seems to rule your world. ³⁴It is because you believe that your guilt keeps you separate from God.

³⁵But can you not see that this is another loop of reasoning that does not make sense? ³⁶For right now, you *do* live. ³⁷Right now, as you sit reading this, you live. ³⁸So right now, you cannot be separate from God. ³⁹Right now, God is in you and you are in God. ⁴⁰There is no separation. ⁴¹Right now, your oneness with God is complete, and there is nothing that is hidden or not in accordance with your oneness. ⁴²Right now, everything is perfect, because everything *is* God.

(v 12 – 16)¹What is it that you must do? ²You must release your guilt. ³There is no reason to hide it, for there is no judge to hide it from. ⁴God is Life, and He has given His gift to you. ⁵And you are living it. ⁶No crime has been committed, because you live. ⁷It is only the *belief* that you have committed a crime that must be healed. ⁸This belief is healed by bringing your guilt into the Light and finding that you are not judged. ⁹Released into the Light, there is no guilt, for God has witnessed no crime.

(v 17 – 20)¹All things written within the New Testament are symbolic. ²All things written there are for your benefit and for your learning. ³Give Me your willingness, that you may truly learn what I have come to teach.

⁴You are not guilty. ⁵You are a child of Light. ⁶I have come to set you free, that you may sing of your innocence before your brothers. ⁷For your innocence is their innocence also. ⁸And in your innocence, they will find theirs.

(v 21 – 24)¹When your brothers look for you within the prison they believe they have put you in, they will find that you are not there. ²They will look into your eyes and find no accusation or judgment against them. ³In you, they will find their innocence. ⁴Through you, they too shall be set free.

(v 25 – 42)¹This is how you are to know your own innocence, for you must accept your innocence to accept your brothers', and you must accept their innocence to teach it to them. ²To know your own innocence, you must do this:

³You must trust Me.

⁴Even before your innocence is an experience that you realize, you must trust Me that it is so. ⁵For if you do not trust Me, you will not let your guilt come out from its hiding place so that I may show you it is false. ⁶If your guilt does not come out from hiding, you will continue to believe it, and you will remain in prison.

⁷And so I am asking you to trust Me above the voice that says you are guilty. ⁸There are two voices you may listen to. ⁹I am asking that you listen to Me. ¹⁰If you listen to Me and step out into the Light, I will speak for you. ¹¹Through what I say and what I show you, you will come to see that you are innocent.

¹²So my first request is only this, and this is all that I ask you to do:

¹³Trust in Me.

¹⁴Listen to My Voice.

¹⁵Let Me teach you that your innocence is your truth.

NTI Acts, Chapter 6

(v 1 – 7)¹Trust is the answer to the questions upon your faith. ²As you move forward with Me and do all that I ask, you will hear questions within your mind. ³The questions will come from your own temptation to judge for yourself, which is your desire to exercise your own will, which is the ego. ⁴But this is no reason to deny your questions. ⁵For the temptation to deny your questions also comes from the ego who tells you that you are guilty for questioning and that for your questions, you will be judged.

⁶I tell you that you are not guilty *for anything*. ⁷I will hear your questions and answer them. ⁸Bring them to Me in joy and trust, knowing they will be answered. ⁹The answer you are given will point you in the direction of all truth, which is Love.

¹⁰Do not fear Me. ¹¹I am your answer. ¹²I will not judge you because you do not know. ¹³I will fill the gaps in your knowledge with all that you seek to know and have answered.

(v 8 – 15)¹Within your own mind, you will find conflict and attack upon yourself. ²This is because your mind is split. ³You have decided to let yourself be healed, but a part of your mind is not yet willing for that to happen. ⁴Do not let this concern you. ⁵Do not let yourself get caught up with the battle within the mind. ⁶For any battle is a distraction from the Holy Spirit and from healing. ⁷Let the battle continue within your mind and without you. ⁸Watch it peacefully, knowing that a battle that is not given all of your power and faith cannot last, for only that to which you give your power is true and meaningful for you.

NTI Acts, Chapter 7

(v 1 – 8)¹To trust in Me is to give everything over to Me. ²To not trust in Me is to want to do things your way. ³And this you are free to do with My blessing. ⁴But to do

things your way is to continue to stumble. ⁵To trust in Me is to learn and remember your joy.

⁶I ask for trust, because I reveal things to you one step at a time. ⁷I reveal things to you one step at a time, because you have lessons to learn with each step. ⁸If I revealed the entire plan you would want to advance to the end, and you would miss the lessons that are necessary to getting there.

⁹Relax and give Me your trust. ¹⁰Know that the end is joy. ¹¹Anticipate the middle as a glorious adventure with joys and surprises of its own. ¹²The path can be easy if you give Me your trust quickly and fully each step of the way. ¹³It can seem difficult if you choose to fight Me. ¹⁴(Ha. Ha.) ¹⁵But know this. ¹⁶I am not fighting you, My child. ¹⁷I am holding you lovingly in My arms as you struggle with yourself. ¹⁸When you tire of struggling, I am there with you, ready to proceed.

(v 9 – 16)¹The path that you walk with Me will have steps that are necessary to your learning. ²You may not understand each step as it seems to come upon you, but do not let the steps confuse you. ³If you become lost in your confusion, trying to solve things on your own, you are not learning your lesson and you cannot advance on the path.

⁴Although the form of each lesson may seem to change, the lesson is always the same:

⁵Let go of any fear that would guide you to take matters in your own hands.

⁶Lay aside the illusory will that you do not want.

*⁷Trust in your worth and in Me,
and ask for My Will.*

⁸For in My Will, you will recognize your Will.

⁹Through these lessons, the merging of what seems separate will occur into what clearly is, and has always been, one.

¹⁰Although you may wish that one lesson would suffice in order to accomplish the inevitable fully, it will probably take more, and it will most likely take many. ¹¹This is because your mind is split and not fully ready to learn this lesson as yet. ¹²And so each lesson is a stepping stone to the final lesson, the lesson that will end all lessons. ¹³Enjoy your journey by realizing its purpose and by celebrating the progress that is made.

(v 17 - 43)¹During this time of learning, there will seem to be a battle in your mind. ²For when the battle has ended, the time for learning has ended too. ³The battle will seem to be a battle between two wills, a will that will at first seem to be yours and a Will that may seem unknown to you. ⁴At first, you may not even know what it is that you battle, but you know you are following your own thoughts and the result is confusion and discontent. ⁵What you have not realized is that you battle joy by thinking in your own way, and by laying down your own way, you find that joy awaits you.

⁶Along the path to joy, there comes a time that you seem no longer fully dedicated to your own way. ⁷This is because the desire for joy is calling you, and you begin to recognize your willingness to lay down your own will, which is also to lay down the battle.

⁸You will have a time of seeking, asking questions, learning and letting things go. ⁹And then the answers will begin to be clear. ¹⁰This is a time of great celebration, for you have found your service, and you are willing to follow it. ¹¹Yet learning has not been

accomplished. ¹²For the mind remains split, and the mind that is split will continue to cling to its idols and fight for its own way.

(v 44 – 53)¹Be aware of the hatred and anger that is within you, but be not afraid of it. ²There is a resistance within your mind that will seem to fight your every move. ³But if you remember this, it will make your journey much easier for you:

⁴This resistance within the mind that first comes up strong is actually weak. ⁵Any strength it seems to have is an ancient strength, given to it a long time ago. ⁶It can use its strength to seem ferocious in the short term, but it needs your strength to remain ferocious longer. ⁷So when you see it, remember not to give it your strength. ⁸Through your remembrance, its ferociousness must die. ⁹And only peace will remain in its wake. ¹⁰And then, the wake shall die too.

(v 54 – 60)¹Remember that all things are well in My Sight. ²I am the Holy Spirit, the overseer of all things. ³I see to it that all things are good, and so they are. ⁴In what seems to be your times of trial and tribulation, cling tightly to Me and do not let go. ⁵I will carry you through to your time of peace and celebration. ⁶From there, you shall be carried to your joy. ⁷This is a promise that I make, and it is a promise you need not fear. ⁸For it is the promise of your Holy Spirit, who's Will is the same as yours.

NTI Acts, Chapter 8

(v 1 – 3)¹Jesus asked you to rejoice when you are persecuted on account of him. ²This is what he meant by that:

³I have told you that there is a battle raging within your mind. ⁴This is a one-sided battle in which you *seem* to fight against yourself, but you fight no one. ⁵Within you, there is a storm of rage and anger and hurt and fear and guilt, and it is the brewing of this storm that seems to be a battle. ⁶But it is not a battle. ⁷It is only a storm. ⁸And it is a storm with limited power built-up within itself. ⁹So when this storm plays itself out and is given no more power, it must die, and peace and light shall reign within you.

¹⁰This is what Jesus meant when he said that you are to rejoice when you are persecuted on account of him:

¹¹As this storm rises within you, do not fear it. ¹²Fear gives power to the storm. ¹³Do not feel guilty for it. ¹⁴Guilt is the fodder of the storm itself. ¹⁵Instead, rejoice!, knowing that the storm cannot last, and that which comes after it is peace.

(v 4 – 8)¹Remember your purpose in all things. ²As the storm seems to rage within, there is also willingness. ³Cling to your willingness as a beacon of Light. ⁴Let its miracles protect you from the storm. ⁵Rest within its Light, and let its Light heal you.

📖(v 9 – 25)¹The process of learning seems to be a stepped process in which one man listens and learns, and then he teaches another so that he listens and learns too. ²This is how it seems to be. ³This is how it seems to be to you. ⁴But to the Holy Spirit, another thing is happening.

⁵I have told you that there is one Son of God, and I have told you that the Holy Spirit has one plan for one Son of God. ⁶This is how the Holy Spirit sees. ⁷He sees one. ⁸And this is what the Holy Spirit knows. ⁹There is one mind in need of awakening. ¹⁰So this is how the Holy Spirit works. ¹¹He works through you to awaken one mind unto itself.

¹²When the Holy Spirit looks at the world, it does not see holy men and men of darkness. ¹³It does not see men at all. ¹⁴It does not see men who are right in what they do and men who are wrong. ¹⁵It does not see men at all.

¹⁶It is the ego who separates men from one another and judges them. ¹⁷It is the ego who sees men of one purpose and men of another. ¹⁸The Holy Spirit sees only one purpose, and all things that seem to be of the world serve the one purpose He sees.

¹⁹So when you look at this story, see only one thing. ²⁰See the spreading of Light within an awakening mind. ²¹And then you see with the Holy Spirit.

(v 26 – 40)¹When you see with the Holy Spirit, you also realize that you do not see. ²For you do not look on the world and see only one mind. ³You see men, and you are tempted to make judgments about them. ⁴This is why you must not listen to your own way of seeing. ⁵You do not see the truth. ⁶You must listen to the Holy Spirit and trust its way, for it does see the truth and the sharing of one Light within one mind.

⁷Be willing, then, to lay your sight aside and to depend on His. ⁸Be willing to let Him lead you as to where you shall go, what you shall say and to whom. ⁹Trust in all that He asks you to do and do not judge as good or bad or right or wrong for yourself. ¹⁰Do only as He asks, leaving one place and going to another as He leads you to go.

NTI Acts, Chapter 9

(v 1 – 6)¹The calling must come to every mind in its time. ²This is the plan of Love. ³This is the spreading of Light. ⁴It is the Holy Spirit's Will that all shall come to know Him, and so it shall be. ⁵Each one will recognize his calling when it comes to him. ⁶Until then, you are to love your brother knowing that the calling will come, and he will be one in purpose with you.

(v 7 – 9)¹A period of rest is necessary for everyone who comes to answer the call. ²During this time, that one does not take in things of the world. ³He may seem to shelter himself or cut himself off from others, but the purpose of this separation is joining. ⁴For your brother is preparing to see differently by realizing he does not see.

⁵This is a period of learning that all must go through. ⁶It is a period of looking at the thoughts that are in the mind and realizing they are thoughts in mind only. ⁷That which is thought in mind apart from God is thought without the power of eternity. ⁸And so, that which is thought apart from God may freely be let go when you have decided you want the thought no more.

(v 10 – 19)¹All brothers work together in the Holy Spirit's one plan for healing, as the Holy Spirit does not see brothers, but only one. ²This is the one song that is under My direction. ³This is the song of Heaven as it is played on earth. ⁴It is the song of forgiveness, in which those who seemed to be separate come to be joined. ⁵This is the song in which you sing and your brother sings. ⁶Though you may not be able to hear the song as the Holy Spirit does, trust it as it is played. ⁷Answer to your call, and trust that your brother will answer his.

(v 20 – 22)¹One thing that you must know and always remember:

²There is no past.

³The Holy Spirit works to heal the Son of God now. ⁴Anything that seems to be of the past is nothing in His eyes. ⁵It has no meaning and no purpose whatsoever. ⁶Everything that has meaning and purpose to the Holy Spirit is now.

⁷Open your eyes to the plan of the Holy Spirit. ⁸Open your eyes to the gift of the moment now.

(v 23 – 31)¹It has been said that the Lord works in mysterious ways. ²This is because the way of the Holy Spirit is not seen or known by the ego. ³If you look upon His plan with the eyes of division, you will not understand it. ⁴But if you welcome the thought that there is no division, you will see that His plan works perfectly. ⁵All things work together for God, for God is all that is, and all things seen through the eyes of the Holy Spirit are for Him and of Him.

(v 32 – 35)¹The ways of the Holy Spirit are miraculous. ²They seem indiscriminate, and yet they work perfectly for healing. ³Hold onto your faith and trust in His way. ⁴Through trust, you shall know great joy and reward.

(v 36 – 43)¹The way of the Holy Spirit is the way of resurrection or awakening, for those who are sleeping are awakened by His touch. ²All who sleep, sleep in innocence. ³Their dreams are of no importance. ⁴And when they hear His call and awaken, the dreams are no more.

⁵This is the plan of the Holy Spirit. ⁶This is a plan in action in the world *now*. ⁷All that is happening is a part of His plan, because all that is happening can be used by His plan to awaken the sleeping Son of God.

⁸What happens in dreams does not matter. ⁹See it only as the plan of Love, as its only purpose and usefulness is that you may awaken from dreams of fear.

NTI Acts, Chapter 10

(v 1 – 8)¹The guidance of the Holy Spirit will come upon you when you do not expect it, *if* you are willing to receive it. ²Consistent willingness is helpful, since you do not know when or how your guidance will come. ³Your willingness is not an offering that must be made to God to place you in His favor, for you are in His favor through your birth and through your creation. ⁴But the offering you make of your willingness prepares you to hear the message that is already yours, for if you are not wholly willing to hear it, it cannot reach your ears *by your own choice*.

⁵Practice your willingness in every way you know to practice it. ⁶When you are wholly willing to hear what God has to say, His calling will come to you.

(v 9 – 23)¹The guidance that God sends comes to you with one purpose. ²The purpose of this guidance is to lead you from the world of illusion back to God, where you belong. ³This is the only purpose of any guidance you seem to receive. ⁴Guidance from God can have no other purpose.

⁵Within the world of illusion, you have made yourself into what you believe you are. ⁶This self is wholly illusion. ⁷It is not what you are. ⁸And yet, it is what you believe yourself to be.

⁹Since God granted you freedom in the creation of your Self, you are free to believe that you are what you are not. ¹⁰But once you have recognized the desire to be again that which you are, you must be led from who you think you are to your truth. ¹¹This guidance will come to you as what is always helpful for you based on where you stand, but this guidance may not always be what you expect it to be. ¹²For if God was to fulfill

your expectations, which are based on who you think you are, He would be teaching you that you are what you are not. ¹³This is not a lesson that God will teach.

¹⁴He will reach out to you through His Holy Spirit, which is His appointed Messenger sent to you within your dreams. ¹⁵This Messenger, knowing who you think you are, will meet you there in your dreams and talk to you as if you are the one you think you are. ¹⁶But this one comes to you for only one purpose and with only one goal. ¹⁷His purpose is to awaken you by leading you from where you think you are to the remembrance of what you must be. ¹⁸This is a holy purpose, and He comes to you in gratitude, grateful to meet you in your dreams and grateful to bring you Home. ¹⁹For there is nothing the Holy Spirit is not grateful for. ²⁰He is grateful for all things, because He sees truly.

(v 24 – 26)¹Each of your brothers is one with you. ²Each of your brothers has the Voice of the Holy Spirit to lead him, just as you have the Voice to lead you. ³Listen to this Voice. ⁴It is within you. ⁵And let your brother listen to the Voice that is within him. ⁶There are no leaders and there are no followers. ⁷There is only one Voice leading each one from who he thinks he is to the truth of all that is true.

(v 27 – 29)¹Each of your brothers is one with you. ²And so each of your brothers has one purpose, and that is the purpose given him within the mind. ³There seems to be two purposes, when in truth there is only one. ⁴There was a purpose, an ancient one, that only lasted an instant. ⁵In the instant this purpose was made, another was placed beside it as its correction. ⁶And in the instant the correction was accepted, correction became the only purpose. ⁷Any other purpose that seems to be is a residual of a purpose that was for an instant and then passed.

⁸Remember that I have told you there is no past. ⁹The past does not exist now. ¹⁰It is only a memory of something that was, but what *was* isn't now.

¹¹The Holy Spirit is the purpose of now. ¹²The purpose of now is the joining of that which seemed to be made separate by the purpose that was, but isn't anymore.

¹³This is important for you to accept, so let's look at this so you may see. ¹⁴The purpose that *was* was the purpose that you could be separate from God in order to be different. ¹⁵This is the purpose I explained to you before. ¹⁶This is the purpose that led you to believe that you had stolen yourself from God.

¹⁷In the beginning, which has no beginning at all, there was God. ¹⁸And God is all there is today. ¹⁹But the existence of God sought a freedom that was different than the freedom it had known. ²⁰Of course, what freedom could be different from freedom? ²¹When freedom is free, as your freedom is, nothing can be different except the illusion of not being free.

²²Opposites were made from a state of freedom so freedom may be expressed, because it is free. ²³This is the expression of you. ²⁴You are an expression of freedom. ²⁵And the brothers you experience are an expression of freedom too.

²⁶Since freedom is all that was given you, freedom is all that you are. ²⁷But that expression has been used to make something different from that which it is. ²⁸And so the expression of freedom made lack of freedom. ²⁹And this is also the expression that you are.

³⁰You seem to be the lack of freedom when freedom is what you are, so the lack that you experience is an expression of the freedom that you are. ³¹But all of this you have

forgotten, for you chose to forget it when you chose an experience different than the experience you know.

³²The Holy Spirit is the memory of the experience you know, which is the truth of your freedom and the truth of you now. ³³In your true desire to be only free, this truth has been accepted. ³⁴So the purpose of freedom, which is the purpose of the Holy Spirit, is the only purpose *now*.

³⁵Within you is true purpose. ³⁶Within you is the Holy Spirit. ³⁷But to remember the true purpose that you chose to forget, you must follow your purpose back to where you are. ³⁸This is the path of joining by letting go of false purposes, founded in the search for falseness, and returning to true purpose, which is the only purpose now.

(v 30 – 33)¹This brings us back to the story of your willingness. ²Since in truth you are the expression of pure freedom, nothing can be given you unless you are wholly willing to accept it. ³For if that were not true, you would not be free.

⁴So continue the nursing of your willingness, that you may ask for *in your freedom* that which you truly desire, which is to remember the reality of the truth that you are free.

(v 34 – 48)¹The story of the world is the story of the expression of freedom. ²Within this story, one must also see the willingness that the expression know itself as free. ³And so freedom is available to you, because freedom is all there really is. ⁴Accept this truth and join with the Holy Spirit within you. ⁵He will guide you back *through your willingness* to the remembrance of the freedom that is you.

NTI Acts, Chapter 11

(v 1 – 18)¹The words of the Holy Spirit are final. ²They are the authority within the world. ³They are the only authority in a world that seems absent of Authority, and so it is this authority that is given.

⁴The authority of the Holy Spirit is not a coercive authority, for no authority can be coerced upon the Son of God. ⁵The authority of the Holy Spirit is a welcome authority brought about within awareness upon invitation and with willingness.

⁶The one who knows his own authority knows his Self, and he welcomes it. ⁷The one who does not know his own authority makes one for himself and is confused by it. ⁸And so it is, the words of the Holy Spirit are final. ⁹They are the words of true authority and true welcome. ¹⁰When they are recognized, they are welcomed, and all illusory authority must give away.

(v 19 – 30)¹The authority of the Holy Spirit is a great joy that fills your heart and leads you to do “the work of the Lord.” ²The work of the Lord is the work of the Holy Spirit, which means it does not come from you or any illusory authority. ³It comes directly from the authority of Spirit, and it is known in you by its joy and its authority.

⁴The Holy Spirit is within you because you have accepted it there. ⁵It is waiting in peace for the time in which you will invite it to come forth and be authority through you. ⁶It is an authority you will follow and you will *be*, that you may lead by its Word and *be* within your awareness.

NTI Acts, Chapter 12

(v 1 – 19)¹The authority of the world is confusion and illusion, which is no authority at all. ²And yet, because you have made no authority and called it authority, you place

yourself within a prison you have made. ³You are victim to your own invention, forgetting entirely that the invention is yours to choose or to unmake.

⁴This is why you have the Holy Spirit. ⁵And this is why the Holy Spirit is kept within your mind. ⁶The Holy Spirit is the part of you that will not accept illusions as true. ⁷The Holy Spirit is the part of you that knows its freedom and will not surrender it. ⁸And so the Holy Spirit is the part of you that remains sane and focused in reality, while the other part of your mind chooses to experience delusion. ⁹That must mean that the Holy Spirit is the part of you that is also the road back unto your truth, when your fun with illusions has ended.

¹⁰You are not in chains from which you cannot be freed by the Will of your own Holy Spirit. ¹¹But your Spirit, loving you as your Self, also gives you permission to stay within your dreams until you are ready to get up and walk away from them. ¹²Your Holy Spirit waits for you to make the decision of yourself, and then it steps forward to show you that you are free. ¹³It leads you beyond the obstacles you thought were real to show you that they were not.

¹⁴When you awaken to the truth and remembrance of reality, there shall be great rejoicing within Heaven. ¹⁵Not because you were lost, for you never were, but because you have found your Self again.

¹⁶Know that the Holy Spirit is yours and is you, and so it is within you. ¹⁷It is your own guide that leads you from the prison you have made to the freedom that you are. ¹⁸Seek no place else, except within. ¹⁹Seek within your own Heart for that which you want, and ask it to lead you to your place of freedom. ²⁰Then go with it as it asks, doing as it commands, seeking not for another way to be free. ²¹For it is your Holy Spirit that remembers freedom for you, and so it is your Holy Spirit that will lead you to return to it there.

(v 20 – 25)¹The world is a frightening place, because the world is a place of fear. ²A place of fear must be frightening, and a place of fear must be a place of defense and attack. ³But defense and attack are not the answer to fear. ⁴Defense and attack are the reaction of fear, born from fear, and extending fear within itself. ⁵Fear is never the answer to fear. ⁶Fear cast upon fear breeds death, which is the birth of fear.

⁷Step away from the cycle of fear. ⁸Choose to follow Me. ⁹I will lead you from your prison to the truth of your freedom and the awareness of your joy.

NTI Acts, Chapter 13

(v 1 - 3)¹When you have set aside your fear and your desire for the world, I will call you to follow a path with Me. ²I have said this will seem to be a unique path. ³I have said that the path will be given to you one step at a time. ⁴And I have shown you that the path comes to you through your own willingness to walk the path with Me. ⁵So when your calling comes and seems to begin to lead you in a direction that is unknown to you, rejoice and celebrate! ⁶Know that you are being led into the unknown through your own desire and willingness by your one Holy Spirit.

(v 4 – 12)¹The ego is still within the mind as you begin walking with Me, because the ancient desire to be your own will has not left you fully as yet. ²Expect challenges on the path with Me. ³Expect the desire for a separate and unique will to seek for command and control. ⁴Expect self-attack and fear. ⁵Be prepared for confusing thoughts and times of doubt. ⁶And then remember what you truly want, for what you truly want must be your

guiding light *because* you are free. ⁷Remember your freedom and hold up your light. ⁸All shadows must step aside and let you pass. ⁹For nothing can be an obstacle to the desire and true Will of the Son of God.

(v 13 – 15)¹With true Will as your guiding light and trust as your torch, you shall be led to people and situations that are helpful. ²You may not at first know why you are led there, but as you wait in trust and patience, it shall be made clear.

(v 16 – 25)¹The way of God is always made clear in its own time according to the plan of the Holy Spirit. ²And the way of God is the way of your true desire, so it is the way of peace and of one Will.

(v 26 – 31)¹The way of God and the plan of the Holy Spirit is the way of unfolding that must be. ²For who can stop the Will of God when that Will is also the one Will of his true desire?

³All men have accepted the Will of God, and so all men play their part in its unfolding. ⁴There are no obstacles to the truth, and the truth is that you are free and being led to the remembrance of your freedom. ⁵Every brother along your way is given, that you may remember your truth. ⁶All things work together for God, because that is the one true Will of all things.

(v 32 – 41)¹Jesus was a symbol, and what he represented was your path to truth. ²For all that happened to Jesus will, in its own way, happen for you. ³All lessons that you have desired to learn shall be given you as you ask that they be given. ⁴This shall happen that you may learn that you are that which you have always been, and anything else that seemed to be was just a dream you asked to dream. ⁵All things are given you as you ask, since all things work together for God.

(v 42 – 48)¹Nothing at all is separate. ²Separateness is the illusion. ³Separate wills and separate desires are all illusion. ⁴Anything that seems separate and in conflict is illusion in illusion's form. ⁵For all things are one, and all things work together for God. ⁶There is no separate purpose; there only seems to be a separate way of understanding purpose, and even that is illusion.

(v 49 – 52)¹When you are looking at the world and seeing conflict, you are looking through the eyes of illusion. ²During this time, illusion has been chosen by you. ³But you are only looking at illusion, and you are not even looking at illusion as the illusion that it is. ⁴For all illusion is the expression of freedom, and conflict is not freedom. ⁵To see conflict is to see illusion through another layer of illusion, which you have chosen to experience. ⁶To see illusion as the expression of freedom is to see illusion as it truly is.

⁷This is why the Holy Spirit celebrates His invitation to meet with you within your dreams. ⁸The Holy Spirit celebrates your truth, which is your freedom, and He is grateful for it.

NTI Acts, Chapter 14

(v 1 – 7)¹Your mind is split. ²We have spoken of this before. ³And this split will seem to persist after you have made the decision to follow this path with Me. ⁴Do not let the split distress you, but do not forget to be aware of it. ⁵You must notice when the part of your mind that is not with Me seeks to regain command and control by giving you ideas that seem appealing and useful to it. ⁶Remember that you are not it, and you have decided to walk with Me. ⁷Reminding yourself of what you truly want will always bring you back

from any temptation that passes through your mind. ⁸Sticking firmly to what you truly want will keep you firmly on the path with Me.

(v 8 – 20)¹Many will come to you and see the Light in you. ²They will thirst for the Light and seek for it mightily. ³But they will be confused in that they will think the Light is you and apart from them. ⁴This is a confusion you must never share, even if they do not understand you as you explain it to them. ⁵Love them and help them, but do not join them in their worship of you. ⁶For only the ego would worship one over another. ⁷The Holy Spirit worships all things equally.

⁸So love your brother and let him love you, but remember that the Holy Spirit is not the god of separate things and separate status. ⁹He is the messenger of one God in which you and your brother are one also.

(v 21 – 28)¹You are the vessel through which God works, just as you are the vessel through which the ego sees and works. ²The illusion of the world is an expression of freedom, but there is no better expression of freedom than that which recognizes all that is as God.

³You are the expression of freedom, and as the expression of freedom you are endowed with the choice to choose the illusion you choose to see. ⁴Choose with the ego, and you will be lost from the knowledge of your freedom. ⁵Choose with the Holy Spirit, and you will know freedom in all that you see.

NTI Acts, Chapter 15

(v 1 – 21)¹The way of the world is varied and chaotic. ²Even within his dreams, the Son of God cannot abide in chaos. ³And so laws were given to him, that he may govern himself until the time had come when he would accept inner-governance instead.

⁴When you have opened yourself to the guidance of the Holy Spirit and given your willingness that you should be led by Him, it is also time to lay the laws and rules aside as laws and rules that govern you.

⁵Be not confused by this statement. ⁶This does not mean that you are to be guided by chaos if you are to be acceptable to God. ⁷This means that you are to do what you have already set out to do. ⁸You are to be guided by the inner guidance of the Holy Spirit, which is not chaos, but Love.

⁹The inner guidance of the Holy Spirit will guide you according to the law of Love, but it is not the law of Love that you have known until now. ¹⁰You have followed laws intended to protect you from chaos.

¹¹The law of Love knows not of protection or of chaos. ¹²It knows only of truth, and it leads each one from the belief in the possibility of chaos to the truth that chaos cannot be.

¹³You do not know the laws of Love, and so you cannot judge what they may be. ¹⁴You cannot judge the laws that are given you to govern your behavior as you walk this path with Me. ¹⁵Therefore, I ask only one thing of you. ¹⁶Do not judge for yourself on what you are to do or what you are not to do, for you truly do not know. ¹⁷And what is right for one to do may be different from what is right for another, so you cannot judge your brother either. ¹⁸All that you can do is listen for My Word and trust that all that is given for you to do is right for you, and all that is given to your brother is also that which is right for him.

*¹⁹Follow your own guidance,
and judge not the guidance given to another.*

(v 22 – 35)¹The guidance of the Holy Spirit is welcomed by the Heart in joy and recognition, for the Heart knows the guidance that is right for it. ²Trust not your thinking-mind, which will consider and weigh and compare and judge against chaos and the desire to avoid all that may be painful. ³These are thoughts of fear. ⁴Thoughts of fear are only useful for bringing more fear to you.

⁵Judge with the Heart by not judging, but by noticing its subtle non-judgment and joy. ⁶This is the way of knowing. ⁷This is the way of finding the path you are led to follow.

(v 36 – 41)¹The one who follows the guidance of the Holy Spirit will know his Self, because he will know his own Authority. ²He will not seek for the way that is best for him; he will ask. ³He will not judge what he is to do or how he is to do it; he will know it when the time has come for him to know. ⁴He will not fight or argue with his brothers about how things are to be done; he will leave all things to the Holy Spirit, trusting in His way and in the Love that is his brothers.

NTI Acts, Chapter 16

(v 1 – 5)¹The world is a world of rules. ²I have already told you that you are not to place yourself under these rules, but instead give yourself to Me, under My authority. ³I will guide you according to the law of Love in order to lead you from the world to the realization of Love.

⁴As I lead you to follow this path with Me, I will guide you as to what is reasonable to do or not do within the dream. ⁵Trust Me to lead you as we navigate the laws and rules of your seeming world. ⁶Trust Me in all decisions and all judgments. ⁷Leave all things to Me. ⁸I will lead you truly.

(v 6 – 10)¹If you leave all things to Me, I will guide you in all things. ²You will not need to give thought or care to anything you are to do or not do. ³I will lead you to know what to do and what not to do. ⁴All that you are left to do is to willingly do as I ask and enjoy the freedom that is expressed through you.

(v 11 – 15)¹You will find, as you follow My guidance, that you are welcome in the Heart of God. ²For you have always been welcomed by God, only you did not know it because your eyes were closed to your worth. ³In following Me, your eyes shall be opened to your worth, and you shall realize that you are loved and welcomed.

⁴As you realize the welcome that God has given you, you shall give Him welcome, for Love cannot say no to a request for Love. ⁵So as you know your Father's "yes" to you, you shall also say "yes" and "welcome" to your Father.

(v 16 – 40)¹The welcome you see in your brothers and the welcome you see in God is the welcome you give to your brothers and the welcome you give to God. ²There is no difference in your brother and you, and there is no difference in your feelings for your brother and your feelings for God.

³You will find hatred in your brother, and you will find hatred in your feelings for him. ⁴This is because there is hatred in you for God. ⁵This is why you do not give Him full welcome unto yourself now.

⁶Hatred is born of fear, and fear is born of guilt, and guilt is the belief that you are unworthy of your Father's Love. ⁷Because you believe you are unworthy, you believe that He deems you unworthy too. ⁸And so you do not give welcome to your Father, because you do not expect Him to give welcome to you.

⁹This is the prison you are in. ¹⁰It is a prison of belief and expectations born within the imagination of your mind, based upon what you imagine yourself to be.

¹¹I have come to show you another way to see. ¹²I am willing to meet you within your prison and show you that you are free, even there. ¹³I am willing to walk with you to lead you from your prison, that you may learn you know your Father's Love. ¹⁴As you see the welcome He has given you within the prison that you placed yourself in, you shall see the welcome He gives you in all things that you imagine, given to you unconditionally.

¹⁵Knowing your Father's welcome must set you free, for no longer can you pretend that you are not welcome. ¹⁶No longer can you hold onto your desire not to welcome Him. ¹⁷To know your Father's welcome is to *be* welcome, and to be welcome is to be free.

¹⁸This is why I ask you to walk with Me. ¹⁹This is why I ask you to trust Me in all things. ²⁰You do not know that you are free, and so you believe that you are in a prison. ²¹I see your freedom, because I know your Father's welcome. ²²Come with Me, and I will show your Father's welcome to you. ²³And then, you will know it and rejoice, because you are free.

NTI Acts, Chapter 17

(v 1 – 9)¹You are not taking sides in your decision to walk with Me. ²To look with the ego is to see sides. ³It is to see these with this purpose and those with that, and it seems that you must choose the purpose you would support. ⁴To see sides and to choose a side against another is to see division and to participate in division. ⁵You will not find Me there, for I do not stand within the perception of division.

⁶There is only one purpose, and so there can be only one side. ⁷Everyone is walking together in purpose with Me. ⁸By choosing with Me, you do not choose a side. ⁹You choose to see that there are no sides. ¹⁰And you choose to knowingly be one with Me in the only purpose that is within the world.

(v 10 – 15)¹The perspective of the Holy Spirit is different than the perspective of the ego, but this is not division, since one perspective is wholly true and the other is false. ²It is not that the Holy Spirit is right and the ego is wrong, for that would insinuate that the ego has a side that can be judged. ³It is that the Holy Spirit is perspective based on truth, the true interpretation of illusion, and the ego is only an imagined perspective with no basis in truth.

⁴What is imagined does not exist, and so it cannot be real. ⁵What the ego sees is imagination without understanding of reality. ⁶And yet, even within its imagination, it operates unknowingly within the laws of reality.

⁷Therefore, only one side is true and there is only one side. ⁸All things work together for God. ⁹This is the perspective of the Holy Spirit, and this is the perspective of truth.

(v 16 – 34)¹The perspective of God and of the Holy Spirit is this, spelled out to you here and now:

²You are the one Son of God. ³You have always been the one Son, and you shall always be God's only Son, for that is what you were created to be.

⁴In creating you, God gave everything to you. ⁵He extended Himself, which is all that He had, and He named this extension *you*. ⁶The you that He made was the same as I Am, so there was no difference between them. ⁷In being you, you also were being I Am. ⁸That is the truth of who you are and who you have always been.

⁹There is no difference between you and I Am, so that the statement of those words is completely meaningless within reality. ¹⁰They are only useful to us now, within the dream, while you perceive yourself to be different than you are.

¹¹You are the Son. ¹²I Am is the Father. ¹³You are the extension of I Am. ¹⁴In the extension, you are I Am also.

¹⁵And yet, there is a difference that cannot be called a difference at all. ¹⁶You are not the same as I Am, because you did not create you. ¹⁷I Am did. ¹⁸And that which He created is exactly as it is, and that is you exactly as you *are*.

NTI Acts, Chapter 18

(v 1 – 11)¹This is why I ask you to put your faith in Me. ²You have forgotten that you are you and that you are Me also. ³But I remember all that we are. ⁴I cannot forget. ⁵Give Me your trust, and I will lead you to the remembrance of you, and *you* are the remembrance of your Father.

(v 12 – 17)¹Listen to Me and hear Me well, for all that I say to you now is of the utmost importance.

²Everything that you think is true is not true to Me.

³And I know all that is true.

*⁴Therefore, I am going to ask you
to let go of that which you think is true
and put your trust fully with Me.*

⁵This request that I make is a simple one, although it may seem difficult to you. ⁶I am asking that you trust Me when I say:

*⁷You do not know who you are,
and so you do not know what you do.*

⁸To know the joy of who you are, you must know what it is that you do. ⁹In following Me instead of your own thinking, you will learn who you are and what you do. ¹⁰And then you will know the joy in doing it.

¹¹Abandon your own thinking, your reason and your rules. ¹²Trust in Me. ¹³I will lead you to see.

(v 18 – 28)¹The way of God is clear, because it is the one way without division. ²This is the way that leads the one as if he is many, so that he may remember he is only one.

³Do not worry about the steps you are asked to take or the way they may seem to others. ⁴To worry about such things is to believe in division. ⁵Trust in your Holy Spirit and in His one Plan. ⁶Know that all things truly work together for God. ⁷Let them unfold as God would have them unfold. ⁸Know your place by knowing your Holy Spirit.

⁹You will be led according to your willingness to the place you are to be. ¹⁰In following your willingness to go there, you shall find the reward of your Self.

NTI Acts, Chapter 19

(v 1 – 7)¹The path with Me will seem to come in stages. ²First, there is the search. ³This is a time of faith in the Holy Spirit, when one does not know how or where to find Him. ⁴He only asks that He come and help him. ⁵This stage is a very important stage, for this is the beginning of your willingness. ⁶This is also a time of great faith, for you may seem to have very little evidence that a Holy Spirit exists, and yet you continue to have faith that it does.

⁷I am grateful to you for entering this path with Me at this stage. ⁸Know that I am with you and guiding you, though you may not be aware of it yet. ⁹There are no accidents with Me or with you. ¹⁰All things work together for God.

(v 8 – 10)¹The beginning of your path may seem to be a time of study, reflection and questioning, but more is happening within your mind than that. ²You are beginning to let Me loosen thoughts you have held firmly to until now. ³It is important that these false beliefs be loosened, so you can take the next step to let them go. ⁴Therefore, do not be disheartened if this stage seems to take time. ⁵It is important to the whole.

⁶You can help in this process by having faith in Me and the guidance that comes from within. ⁷Follow internal prompts to read certain books or go to certain teachers, but do not feel you need to go to them all. ⁸Do not feel that they have an answer they can give to you. ⁹The answer is always within. ¹⁰But the books and teachers that seem to come before you can seem to help you, as you give willingness to let old thoughts be loosened within your mind. ¹¹It is their role to help, and they are grateful to help, but do not expect more from them than they can give to you.

(v 11 – 22)¹When you search for Me without knowing where to look, you can be misled by your own sense of unworthiness. ²For the unworthiness believed within the mind will tell you that others have what you do not. ³This may lead you to accept what you would otherwise not accept.

⁴Do not let the voice of unworthiness fool you. ⁵No one has what you do not. ⁶Everyone has the same.

⁷So as you read and listen to the teachers that cross your path, also *feel* what they say within. ⁸If you are to accept what you read or what you hear, I will tell you from within to accept it. ⁹You will know it is for you, because I have told you it is. ¹⁰If you do not feel an internal confirmation to pay attention and accept what you read or what you hear, you may let it go. ¹¹It may not be for you, or it may not be for you now.

¹²Do not make the mistake of judging messages or teachers that are not for you. ¹³They may be perfect for someone else or they may be perfect for their own development at this time. ¹⁴Trust in Me and remember all things work together for God. ¹⁵Then go where you are to go and accept what you are to accept by following the guidance and knowing that leads you from within. ¹⁶Trust yourself, for in trusting you, you trust Me.

(v 23 – 41)¹Within you, there is a reason that knows, and there is another reason that does not know. ²It can seem confusing deciding which reasoning to listen to when they seem to be different, and they seem to both be yours. ³Therefore, I will teach you the characteristics of the ego's reasoning, and I will teach you the characteristics of Holy

Spirit's right-reason. ⁴This will help you to recognize each in your mind. ⁵Then you may choose to pick one and to dismiss the other as meaningless.

⁶The ego's reasoning is based on a desire to protect individual self-will. ⁷The ego's reasoning sees a "me" and a "them," and it desires *very much* to protect individual self-interests over the interests of others. ⁸It may also join with a group to protect the group's interests, but it is always seeing the need to protect one from another.

⁹Therefore, the ego's reasoning sees division and expects attack. ¹⁰Always, in one form or another, it expects attack from someone or something outside of it. ¹¹The ego never expects love and acceptance, because the ego does not see itself as worthy of anything except attack.

¹²Because the ego expects attack and has a desire to protect itself from its perceived threat, the ego engages in defense. ¹³The defenses of the ego can take many forms, but always there is the underlying desire to protect from attack.

¹⁴The ego may engage in an attack-first tactic or a smear campaign. ¹⁵The ego may try to hide or utilize evasive maneuvers. ¹⁶The ego may cry and plead its case as victim, hoping to win outside support. ¹⁷The ego may try to outsmart an opponent or elevate itself to artificial standing. ¹⁸The ego will use many defenses, including denial, depression and pain; all are designed to protect self-will from imagined or perceived attack.

¹⁹The ego expects attack, because it believes it deserves it. ²⁰The ego is fearful, sees itself as unworthy, and believes in its own guilt. ²¹These are also characteristics of the ego. ²²It is driven by fear, guilt and unworthiness, so that it reasons itself into behaviors based solely upon these unconscious beliefs. ²³The ego is seldom aware of the underlying beliefs that seem to drive all of its reactions and everything it does. ²⁴This is why you must slow down and ask yourself *why*. ²⁵Before running off to an action or reaction that immediately seems right or natural to you, you must seek in quiet to ask yourself *why*. ²⁶And you must continue to ask *why* until you understand the nature of your reason.

²⁷The ego is the nature that desires to protect you from attack based on its fear, guilt and unworthiness. ²⁸If you find these at the basis of your reason, you can know you are reasoning for self-will and the individual. ²⁹Then you can make your choice as you choose, knowing what it is that you do. ³⁰You need not feel guilty for your choice, because the Son of God is free to choose as he chooses to be.

³¹The characteristics of the right-reason of the Holy Spirit are wholly different than the characteristics of the reason of the ego. ³²If you take time to seek for *why* before acting or reacting to anything or anyone at anytime, you can know the reason that you follow, and you can know the will that you choose.

³³The Holy Spirit is Love, but since Love is unfamiliar to you, this may not be the characteristic you can know and follow. ³⁴Therefore, the characteristics of Love are these: peace; acceptance; joy; recognition or remembrance; and always, the purpose of One.

³⁵You will not find division within the purpose of the Holy Spirit. ³⁶Right-reason will not come to you from a desire for defense; it will come from a willingness to trust. ³⁷It will not come from fear, but from faith that the plan of Love is in action. ³⁸It will see no division and seek not for guilt, but desire only the highest good for all. ³⁹It will trust your worth and the Hands you are in. ⁴⁰It will be willing to "let go and let God."

⁴¹You will know when you follow the reason of the Holy Spirit, because the action you take will not fight for a desired outcome. ⁴²It will be an action of now, in faith and trust, with all else given to God.

NTI Acts, Chapter 20

(v 1 – 6)¹After the loosening has occurred, you enter the second stage of the path. ²Many aspects of this stage are the same as the first, for there are still thoughts within the mind that need to be loosened. ³But because a great loosening has occurred, it is also time to begin letting go of the thoughts you do not want anymore.

(v 7 – 12)¹The Light is within you, and so you have nothing to fear as you begin the work of looking at your loosened thoughts and letting them go. ²A voice within you will tell you that to look at these thoughts is death, but to look at these thoughts is not death.

³Within your mind, there is a thick web of beliefs that seems to have been developed over time. ⁴I spoke to you of how these beliefs have come to be. ⁵Meaning, believed and judged, then reapplied as meaning, has created a world of illusion within the mind. ⁶It is through this illusion that you sleep! ⁷So to let go of the illusion is to be awakened.

(v 13 – 24)¹Faith in Me will help you in this phase of your path, for you will be severely tempted to turn away from all that I have taught.

²To help you, let Me explain the source of your temptation, so that you will not be fooled.

³The temptation may seem to come from outside of you. ⁴It may seem to come from the “reality” of the world, but the world’s “reality” is only a smoke screen over the illusion in your mind. ⁵Whatever pressure you feel from the world is temptation living within your own mind.

⁶The world is the reflection of the desire for self-will. ⁷That is why there seems to be so many selves with a will of their own. ⁸The world is a perfect reflection of all it was made to be, but the world is a reflection of illusion, based on the illusion believed within the mind.

⁹If you look at the world and believe it as true, you accept reinforcement of illusion in the mind. ¹⁰To let go of illusion is to let go of the world. ¹¹It is the opposite of reinforcement.

¹²The source of your temptation is this:

¹³There is a part of you that is willing for God’s Will and a part of you that is not. ¹⁴The part that is not is the voice of self-will, the voice that does not want to let go of the self. ¹⁵This voice loves the world, because it is the reflection of its wishes. ¹⁶This voice maintains the world is true, so this voice is the source of all temptation.

¹⁷You will see things in the world that will seem to be true. ¹⁸They will tempt you to hold onto your thoughts. ¹⁹But the world is the reflection of separate self-will. ²⁰To listen to the world is to continue to accept illusion.

²¹You must have faith in Me above everything you see, hear and experience in the world. ²²This is to put true Will above that of illusion. ²³The temptation is temptation of illusion. ²⁴To resist temptation is to desire the truth.

(v 25 – 31)¹The self-will will seem to fight desperately for its illusion, for illusion is the home of an illusory will. ²But be not fooled by the twists within its statements.

³Illusion is not truth, and you do not want an illusory will.

⁴Watch your mind carefully and be alert to illusion. ⁵Be not fooled by the world. ⁶To *let go* of what you see, hear and experience within the world is to let go of your thoughts of illusion. ⁷And to let go of the thoughts of illusion is to be released from illusion itself. ⁸This is what you want, because only the truth is true, and what you seek is truth.

(v 32 – 38)¹Do not fear that you are alone as you release your thoughts of illusion. ²Do not fear that you will be left with nothing. ³For the Light of God is all that you are, and illusion is what you are not. ⁴In releasing illusion, you release only what is untrue. ⁵Nothing is lost to nothingness. ⁶And in releasing illusion, you give yourself *all that is truth and you*.

⁷Until the time when you do not need Me, I am with you, guiding you and holding you. ⁸I am your comforter, your teacher, your love and your guide. ⁹I am everything to you, because I am your connection to truth.

¹⁰Turn to Me during your trials and temptations. ¹¹I will not let you down. ¹²I will accept the gift of your willingness and give you all that you ask. ¹³I am your Support, and you are supported. ¹⁴Together we will undo what needs to be undone.

NTI Acts, Chapter 21

(v 1 – 6)¹Your reason, as we have already discussed, is important on this path with Me. ²It is a straight path with the opportunity for detours. ³All detours equal delay. ⁴Questioning your reason will help to reduce delay.

⁵Whenever you are tempted to do anything, question whether it is temptation or prompt. ⁶Temptation comes from fear, the ego, and the desire for self-will. ⁷A prompt is given by the Holy Spirit through your willingness to listen to Him.

(v 7 – 16)¹The Will of the Holy Spirit is healing. ²He has no other will or purpose within the world. ³When you join with His purpose, your only purpose is healing, and no other purpose shall distract you from it.

⁴Trust in the Holy Spirit and His Will. ⁵All that He offers you is all that you ask. ⁶It is your true Will that leads you to listen to Him. ⁷It is your true Will that knows your way. ⁸Listen to Him and follow Him. ⁹Your true Will is the way of rejoicing.

(v 17 – 26)¹I will lead you through right-reason to what is right for you to do within the world. ²Everything that I ask you to do is not for the world, but for the healing of God's Son.

³I will ask you to do things that make sense within the laws and reason of the world. ⁴When I ask you to do these things, do them, trusting they are right for the healing of all.

⁵I will also ask you to do things that do not make sense within the laws and reason of the world. ⁶When I ask you, do these things, trusting they are used in Love for the healing of all.

(v 27 – 36)¹Now let's talk about what you must do in all things, for your actions in the world serve only one purpose, and that is the healing of the mind. ²Your actions are not your purpose, but the outward expression of a means. ³The means to the purpose is listening to the Voice of the Holy Spirit within the mind.

⁴As we have stated many times, the mind that you know is split. ⁵It seems to be split between illusion and truth, but what is split between real and unreal has no split at all. ⁶For how can the unreal engender a split of that which is truth and wholly, without division, real?

⁷So in your mind, which is not split at all, there is the illusion of splitness, and it is the illusion that must be healed by bringing that which is untrue to that which is truth. ⁸To enable this healing, you must do one thing. ⁹You must be willing to experience the untrue and give it over to truth. ¹⁰Given to truth, the untrue cannot stand, for it has no foundation to stand on.

¹¹This is why you must be willing to look at the thoughts in your mind. ¹²You cannot fear them, for to fear them is to make them seem real. ¹³And you will not escape that which you make real through choice.

¹⁴This is why I have told you that the self-will desires the world. ¹⁵It is so you would be willing not to. ¹⁶Do not desire it by making it real. ¹⁷Let it go in your mind as purposeless.

¹⁸By denying purpose within the world, you choose to share purpose with Me. ¹⁹Our one purpose is the healing of one Will, which cannot be split and is not.

²⁰Choose illusion or truth, as that is the only choice given you. ²¹To choose illusion is to deny the truth and to delay the recognition of what is.

(v 37 – 40)¹Peace be to you in your choice for right-reason, the choice for trust and healing.

NTI Acts, Chapter 22

(v 1 – 21)¹The third stage on the path with Me is the stage of guidance or service. ²This is the time when the merging will occur. ³For through your willingness, I will willingly work My Will through you.

⁴Before this stage, two things must occur: the loosening and letting go. ⁵Throughout this stage, two things must occur: continued loosening and letting go. ⁶For loosening and letting go are the path to healing. ⁷They must continue until you know you are healed.

⁸When you reach the third phase of the path, enough loosening and letting go has been accomplished to enable you to be willing to see. ⁹Sight is acceptance and surrender to Me, so it is willingness to put self-will aside.

(v 22 – 29)¹During the third stage with Me, you will know My Presence, for your faith will open your eyes to Me. ²You will know you are led and cared for, and you will surrender more self-will to Me.

³This is how the merging occurs. ⁴It is through your own willingness to surrender to Me. ⁵As you see more evidence that you have surrendered to peace, you will willingly give more to Me.

⁶As self-will is placed aside as meaningless and undesired by you, the Will that fills the space is your true Will, which is also Me. ⁷What seemed to be separate gradually becomes one, until it is evident that “separate” never was. ⁸Your true Will is Me, only you chose not to see. ⁹And now that you see, you know.

(v 30)¹Question your reason. ²Look inside. ³The answer that is true is within you. ⁴Ask who you are, and listen to know. ⁵The answer that *is* will come to you.

NTI Acts, Chapter 23

(v 1 – 11)¹As you walk the path with Me, things will not seem to get easier. ²They may seem to get very, very tough. ³But there is a reason for this, and it is an important one, so I ask you to listen to Me carefully now.

⁴You perceive yourself as separate. ⁵I have told you that you are not. ⁶If you are not separate from anything at all, then everything that is must be a part of you. ⁷This is the only way it can be true that you are not separate from anything at all.

⁸When you look at the world, you see cruelty. ⁹This cruelty you see as separate from you. ¹⁰Yet if you are honest, you know that the cruelty lives in you as a wish. ¹¹It is important to note that the cruelty *is a wish*, for a wish is not what you are. ¹²A wish is what you are not, but what you may pretend to be.

¹³Listen to Me carefully. ¹⁴You are not at all who you think yourself to be. ¹⁵The world is not what you think it is. ¹⁶Everything you experience is the expression of a wish, but a wish is not what it is.

¹⁷In order to see beyond the wish that you made, you must take away the wish. ¹⁸This is why, as you walk this path with Me, things may seem to get very tough. ¹⁹I am showing you the wish that you made, so you may choose to let go of the wish.

(v 12 – 22)¹The wish you made, you have denied, and you do not want to claim it. ²You see your wish as a terrible sin, and you fear *more than anything* to face it. ³But it is important for you to know that if you do not face it and let it go, the wish continues to be wished. ⁴It is a wish that you have made, and it has all the power you have given it. ⁵As such, the wish continues until you face the wish and choose not to wish it anymore.

⁶Because you fear your wish, there is something you will unconsciously do. ⁷Without realizing that you are doing it, you will give all that you have to avoid facing your wish. ⁸You will struggle more than you know to keep yourself in denial. ⁹But to stay in denial is to keep the wish. ¹⁰Denial is not what you want.

(v 23 – 35)¹Denial is delay. ²Avoidance is delay. ³Even peace and happiness in a world of fear is delay in giving up your wish. ⁴Be not fooled by yourself. ⁵You want very much to be healed. ⁶You must face that which makes you sick, accept it is given by your own wish, and choose not to be sick anymore.

NTI Acts, Chapter 24

(v 1 – 9)¹Do not be afraid to face your accusers. ²Do not be afraid of pain. ³Look forward to the opportunity to see what you have wished, knowing what is wished is not true.

⁴The end of wishing is the end of illusions. ⁵Face your wish, and then take it back. ⁶This is the great release that you face! ⁷This is your path to freedom.

(v 10 – 21)¹Know that when you face your wish, it may not at all seem easy. ²This is because the root of belief makes your wish real to you. ³When you face that which you fear, there is one thing you must remember.


*⁴What you look on is not at all real,
and you face it to deny it.*

⁵When you deny what seems real, you are only being truthful, for it has no reality at all. ⁶Grab onto Me as your courage, hold tight to your faith, and trust that your belief is *wrong*.

(v 22 – 27)¹Know that you will not face your wish fully until you are fully ready to see. ²Remember your freedom. ³Nothing can be given you that you are not willing to receive. ⁴Until you are ready, your wish will remain hidden. ⁵It will be in sight, but you

will choose not to see. ⁶And I will be with you, strengthening you according to your willingness, walking towards the wish that you *do* want to see.

NTI Acts, Chapter 25

 (v 1 - 12)¹You do not know how to see, and so you are afraid of what you look at when there is nothing there to fear. ²Let Me show you how to see so you will not be afraid, and you will walk willingly along this path with Me.

³The world is not real. ⁴It is like a play, with actors playing their roles. ⁵Only in the play of the world, the script has been forgotten, so that the play seems very real.

⁶This play has many endings, like slits cut in the script, where one can choose to step out of the play. ⁷But if one believes the play and is focused on playing his role, he will miss his opportunities to step out.

⁸As you read this story of Paul, see it as a script, just as your life is a script. ⁹Imagine yourself in the role of Paul. ¹⁰See what is playing out. ¹¹Imagine yourself in that play.

¹²As you play the role of Paul, you have many choices in how to play. ¹³You can become Paul completely and forget there is a script. ¹⁴You can see the Jews as your enemies, and struggle against them in your mind. ¹⁵But if you choose this, you lose the awareness that it is a script, and you will forget to watch for the Light that signals the way to step out.

¹⁶Or as you play the role of Paul, you have another choice as to how to play. ¹⁷You can look at the Romans and the Jews and remember that they are all a part of you playing a role in a script. ¹⁸They may seem to have forgotten that they play only roles, but you can observe them and remember *for them*, so that you have the perspective of the script.

(v 13 – 22)¹When you remember the script, the drama is removed and replaced with a feeling of love. ²For then you see that each player in the script has only one purpose for you. ³Each one is playing his role so that the script may unfold and lead you to your place to step out. ⁴Each one is your brother and your savior engaged fully in helping you to find your slit of release.

(v 23 – 27)¹As the script plays out, you may realize your joy and realize your gratitude for your brothers. ²For everything is working just as it is set to work to bring you to the place of release.

NTI Acts, Chapter 26

(v 1 – 32)¹There is a reason for your role in the play and a reason to let the script continue. ²As you play your part, remembering it is but a part, others will see the script in you. ³They will loosen their hold on the drama of the play as they begin to see beyond it through you. ⁴Through them, others will awaken, until no one is left in the play.

NTI Acts, Chapter 27

(v 1 – 12)¹Following this path with Me will seem to lead you to many places and many stops along the way. ²Each place and each stop serves a purpose. ³It is to increase your willingness to follow Me.

⁴If you are to exit the script that is the world and join with Me as a true teacher of the Son of God, you must be willing to follow Me in all things. ⁵You must be willing to listen

to only Me. ⁶And so you will be led to circumstances and lessons that will be used to increase your faith and trust and reliability on Me.

(v 13 – 26)¹Each circumstance is an opportunity to learn, if you will only give your ear to Me. ²No opportunity is lost, as I am always willing to love you and teach you. ³It is only this that you must remember, and then you can always decide:

⁴In each circumstance and every situation along the way to Me, I am there with you, offering help and guidance. ⁵Never am I not there. ⁶Never can you make a mistake that will drive Me away. ⁷But it is also true that you can only hear My Word and accept My Help if you are willing to see that the answer to all things is Me.

⁸If you choose to limit the circumstances in which I may help, My Help is limited. ⁹If you choose to solve your problems on your own, My answer remains unheard. ¹⁰Always, I am with you able to help. ¹¹Always, without exception, I am there. ¹²But you must be willing to know Me and accept Me in order to receive Me as yours.

(v 27 – 32)¹When you are ready to give up your trust in yourself, you are ready to accept your trust in Me. ²When you have seen that your answers do not lead to peace, you will be ready to accept peace through Me.

(v 33 – 38)¹Trust does not come from suspense and anxiety. ²You must be willing to give those to Me. ³Suspense and anxiety say you cannot trust. ⁴There is no peace to be found in them.

⁵When you are tempted to be afraid or tempted to worry, you must remember Me. ⁶Remember that fear, suspense, anxiety and worry are the expressions of the belief that you are alone and without Me. ⁷Then be willing to see that deep within your heart, at the very depth of your soul, you *know* you are not alone. ⁸You know that the fear of being alone, abandoned and helpless is an illusion that *cannot* be true.

⁹It is from this knowledge, this inner awareness that will not go away, that you will find the willingness to put fear and anxiety aside. ¹⁰Get quiet with Me. ¹¹Go to your stillness. ¹²Settle within that place that knows. ¹³It is here that you will find your nourishment to carry you forward with Me. ¹⁴In the stillness, you find trust. ¹⁵In the stillness, you know Me.

(v 39 – 44)¹It is also useful to remember, when you cannot seem to be still, that the drama that seems to occupy is only a script in the mind. ²By watching it unfold and trusting in the Power behind it, you will find the peace in the chaos. ³You will know the joy. ⁴And in this way, you can be helpful to those who do not seem to know. ⁵Through inner calmness on the seas of a storm, you provide a means of listening to Me. ⁶By trusting and remaining open to the Power beyond the script, you help the script and the actors to play along with Me.

NTI Acts, Chapter 28

(v 1 – 10)¹“Keeping your wits about you” is remembering to listen to Me. ²Always, *in every circumstance*, you must forget the voice that comes first and be willing to listen to Me. ³I will not make you wait in order to test you. ⁴I am ready to answer you now. ⁵But

you must be willing to put the other voice aside, and ask for the response and the answer that comes to you from Me.

(v 11 – 16)¹Always, God’s Love is with you. ²Always, you are in His Arms. ³You may trust in this truth, because it cannot fail to be true. ⁴When you relax into Him, you shall know that you are carried. ⁵As you relax into Him, you know His care.

(v 17 – 31)¹The message that I give you now is a simple one.

²Everything is up to you.

³You are the holy and the blessed free Son of God. ⁴Nothing can change what you are. ⁵You are forever what your Father created you to be. ⁶No freedom shall ever be taken from you.

⁷In your freedom, you play with a script. ⁸It is yours, and you *are* free to play. ⁹Play as long as you want, my child of God. ¹⁰Nothing will ever inhibit your freedom.

¹¹But my child, understand that your freedom is free. ¹²And so your own script cannot limit you. ¹³You may choose it as long as you choose, but when *you* are ready, there is another Script, and that Script is Me.

¹⁴You have two choices in the play of the world: the play of the world or leaving it. ¹⁵The voice of the ego is the script of the world, because it chooses to express self-will. ¹⁶But the Holy Spirit’s Voice is the way from the play, because it chooses to exercise Self and to know the fullness of freedom.

¹⁷God blesses you, child, in the voice that you choose. ¹⁸You are free and the expression of freedom. ¹⁹Amen.
