Question: It seems that the crucifixion of Jesus was unfair. It seems that Jesus chose sacrifice so that we could all learn. On the other hand, we learn that God's justice is never unfair and God does not require sacrifice. How is this seemingly horrific scene seen through the eyes of Love?

Answer: The answer is simple if you remember that the world is not real. It is an illusion made by the ego, which is the belief in separation. This belief maintains itself, as that is its only purpose. The crucifixion is just a reflection of that one ego belief. It contains separateness, attack and guilt regardless of the angle you seem to be watching from. Whether you stand there watching *for* Jesus or *against* him, you find someone to see as separate from you, guilty and worthy of attack.

Now I ask you to release your mind from all of these points of view, for they are all the same.

Now, invite your mind to sit with Love and watch this scene again. When you do, you will see confusion, for the ego's thought system can be nothing else. You will see no one as right and no one as wrong, for neither is present in Love. You will see your brothers who wanted peace, security and Love for themselves, but they did not understand that it was within themselves. So whether they seemed to be for Jesus or against him, they were looking outside themselves for what they could never find there.

And this is what Jesus saw. Whether he looked in the eyes of his apostles or the hearts of the ones we call his enemies, he saw the same desires and the same confusion. And this is why he chose to teach this dramatic lesson: *The kingdom of God is within*. It is not in a man who walks and teaches and Loves, nor is it in ridding the world of a man you see as a threat. Peace is within.

So the symbol of Jesus was removed from the world of form and placed within our hearts that we may learn the Truth from ourselves.

We are the Answer we seek.

A friend wrote to me asking: This is a little strange but do you know of any way to get out evil spirits?

I took the question within and received this answer:

Evil spirits are a projection of the mind that believes in separateness. In this way, evil spirits are no different than seeming evil behaviors in the world, death is no different than

"life." All confusion and all fear comes from the ego, and although the forms may seem different to you, they are all the same and so the Answer is always the same.

Once again I ask you to remember that there are only two, and this time I will clarify that those two are Truth and illusion. Everything that isn't Truth is illusion, and the Answer is accepting the Truth and freeing the mind from illusion.

One point of confusion regarding illusion is caused by the illusion itself. You see yourself as separate and believe yourself to be an individual, so when I speak about projection, you are thinking as an individual that if it is your projection, others would not witness it. Because the projection is also witnessed by others, you think it must be real. But this confusion is based on the belief in separateness. You will not be confused if you remember there is only one mind and all projections proceed from it. The "you" you think you are proceeds from this source, and as long as you continue to identify with its basic belief, you will experience its seeming effects, regardless of the form.

The good news is that the Answer has already been given, and that Answer is within you. Seek ye first the Kingdom of Heaven, and all else will be given *because* all illusions will fade away, including the illusions of evil spirits. They are illusion, and they cannot harm the Truth of who you Are.

Turn inside and ask your Father for help. Await in peace his Answer. It will come, for the Answer is already yours.

The New Testament is a symbol, just as you are a symbol and the words I share through you are a symbol. What they point to is Truth.

In order to understand the symbol, one must accept the Love of Christ. One prepares himself to accept that Love by recognizing he does not understand the symbol, and then he asks for understanding. By opening up to receive understanding without judgment, he opens up to accept the Love of Christ. With that Love comes Christ's knowledge, for they are the same and inseparable. Then the meaning that is beyond the words is understood as a Light that shines for all who look to see.

Those who have ears now will listen. For others, salvation will wait. There is no loss in God. Ask and you will receive *because* it will be given you.
