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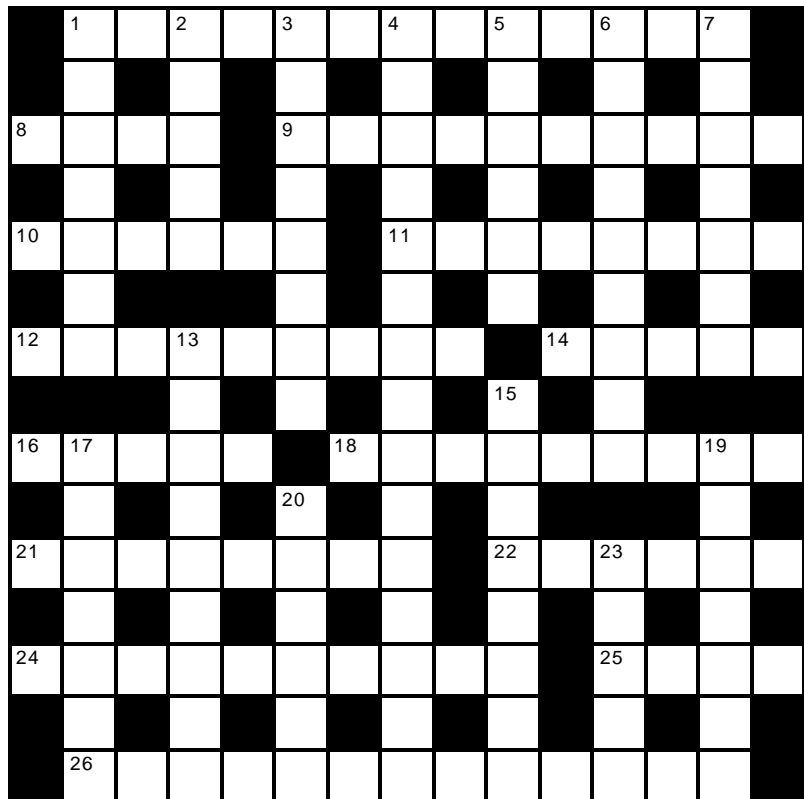
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## Across

### 1 SIX TIMES TABLE

This is lesson one when learning Latin, declining "mensa", the word for "table" (also used by MENSA: the 'high IQ club')

### 8 T-BAR

Move little Bartholomew (BART) around here = T-BAR: for the lift.

### 9 THREATENED

"Her date ten" different ways, an anagram = THREATENED: menaced.

### 10 CO-A-X-ER

The officer in charge (CO) that a (A) No. 10 (X) goes to the emergency room (ER) = COAXER: he persuades.

### 11 HONG KONG

H/G (H ON G) K/G (K ON G) = HONG KONG.

### 12 ALGORITHM

Uses "a logarithm" to make ALGORITHM: this formula.

### 14 SLYLY

The 'proverbial' fox is SLY, in the form of an "adverb" = SLYLY

### 16 C-RAFT

At sea (C) this raft (RAFT) = CRAFT: becomes a boat.

### 18 S(T-RING)ENT

Sent (S-ENT) around the ring after tea (T-RING) = STRINGENT: being inflexible.

### 21 TURNPIKE

"Run ... I kept" moving, an anagram = TURNPIKE: for the highway.

### 22 PES-ETA

After the gym classes (PES) is expected to arrive (ETA) = PESETA: the money.

### 24 C-A-PI-TA-LI-ST

Is to see (C) a private investigator (A PI) back at (TA) the 51st (LI-ST) = CAPITALIST: the money man.

### 25 ICBM

Initially, the first letters of "It Came Before Making" = ICBM: the (Inter-Continental Ballistic) Missile

### 26 BIG BANG THEORY

"The boy barging" around, an anagram = BIG BANG THEORY: it all started with.

## Down

### 1 SUB'S-OIL

The u-boat's (SUB'S) used to keep the engines running smoothly (OIL) = SUBSOIL: dirt.

### 2 XEROX

To XEROX is to copy, taken from the copier company XEROX.

### 3 INTER-MIX

Put in the ground (INTER) in 1009 (MIX) = INTERMIX: so they're together now.

## 4 EARTH-SHATTERING

"Heart" is an anagram of EARTH, and both "breaking" and SHATTERING indicate anagrams. Heart-breaking = EARTH-SHATTERING: on a global scale.

### 5 TRA-IN-S

A beach (TRA) in the South (IN S) = TRAINS: gets fit for.

For our non-Irish speakers, TRA is the Irish word for beach.

### 6 BREAK A LEG

Good luck to the acting = BREAK A LEG, and an anagram of (i.e. break) A LEG is "Gael".

### 7 ETERNAL

"End" with "less" = endless = ETERNAL

### 13 OFF-ENDING

In the OFF-ice of Public Works, the OFF-ENDING is -ice of Public Works.

### 15 DI'S-PATCH

Diana's (DI'S) cure for smoking (PATCH) = DISPATCH: send out.

### 17 RHUBARB

With that kangaroo (ROO) Barbara (BARB) = ROO-BARB, I hear as RHUBARB: is in a jam.

### 19 NOT-ABLY

Not (NOT) with competence (ABLY) = NOTABLY: but with distinction.

### 20 PIN-A-TA

Nip back (PIN) with a thank you (A TA) = PINATA: for the birthday entertainment.

### 23 S-L-I-GO

The south (S) gets fifty (L) before I go (I GO) = SLIGO: out west.
