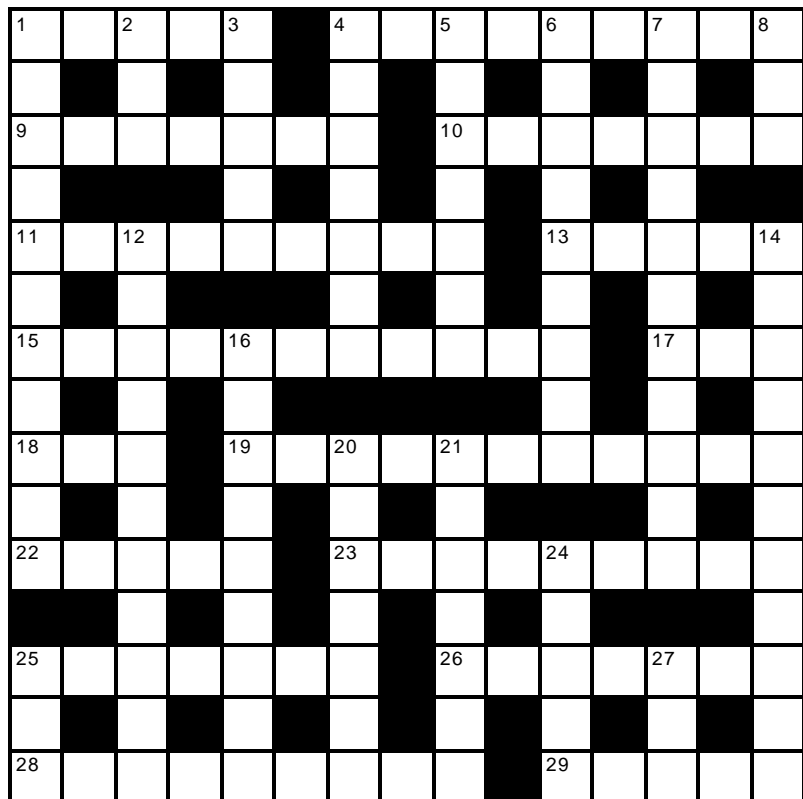

Be coy about (CO-Y) the New Testament rovers (NT ROVERS) = CONTROVERSY: dispute.

The first saint's (ST-ONE'S) toss (THROW) = STONE'S THROW: was quite close.

14 ST-AND-ST-ILLS

The two saints (ST-AND-ST) with the ills (ILLS) = STANDSTILLS: stops.
