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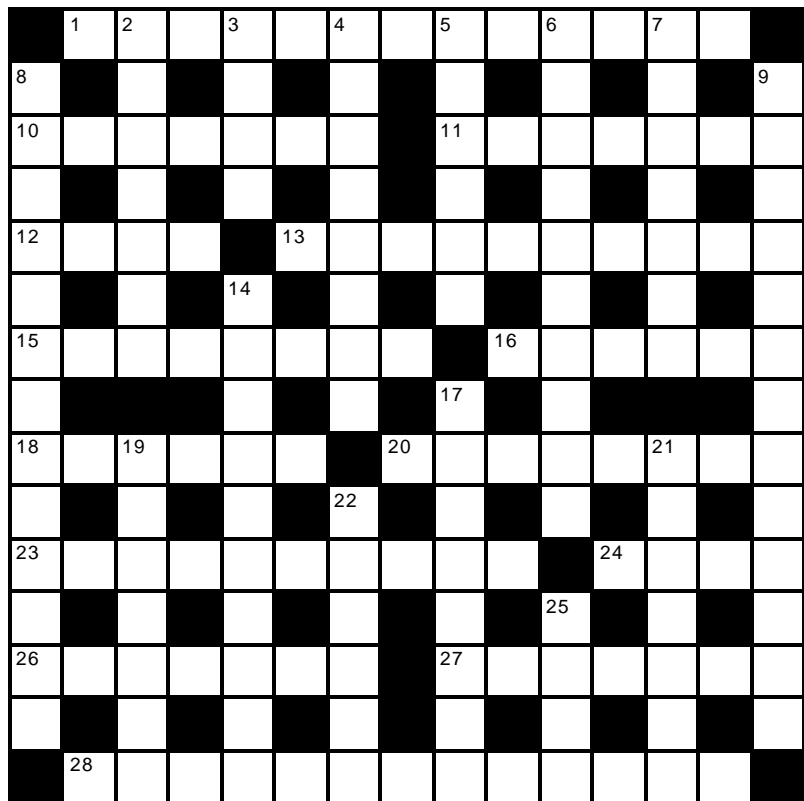

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## Across

### 1 CLIMATE CHANGE

"Camel" with "it" is an anagram, a CHANGE to the word CLIMATE = CLIMATE CHANGE: a global problem.

### 10 ARC-H-I'VE

Bow (ARC) before the hour (H) I have (I'VE) = ARCHIVE: set aside for preservation.

### 11 ORCHARD

Found in po-OR CHARD-onnay = ORCHARD: it supplies fruit.

### 12 BRIM

There's b-A-ri-U-m, but no gold (delete AU from barium) = BRIM: around the hat.

### 13 ALL-EG-IAN-CE

All (ALL) for example Ian (EG IAN) to Clare (CE) = ALLEGIANCE: the devotion shown by.

### 15 EARNINGS

From the "grannies" dancing = EARNINGS: profits

### 16 INGEST

You tell me you're joking (IN JEST) I hear as = INGEST: and yet you eat this.

### 18 OFF-A-LY

It's not on (OFF) before the middle of M-a-y (A) and after the end of Ju-ly (LY) = OFFALY: OY (on a number plate).

### 20 OUT-E-R EAR

Is not in (OUT) key (E) and behind (R-EAR) = OUTER EAR: everything in front of the (ear)drum.

### 23 SHOP WINDOW

A "setting" where one "browses" the merchandise.

### 24 LIES

Decapitated dol-lies = LIES: you can have a pack of these.

### 26 RUM-MAGE

Some Bacardi (RUM) and that crazy "game" (MAGE) for = RUMMAGE: root around.

To (TO) Mr. Geller's (URI'S) monsieur (M) = TOURISM: travel business.

Mixing "reining" in the "martyr" = INTERMARRYING: mixing religions.

Someone with even more of the "luck of the Irish" perhaps.

### 3 MA-I'D

The degree (MA) I would (I'D) = MAID: like a young woman.

### 4 THE(O-L-OG)Y

They (THE-Y) take in [around (O) fifty (L) and go back (OG)] for = THEOLOGY: religious study.

### 5 CO(OK)ED

With boys and girls (CO-ED) about it's okay (OK) = COOKED: maybe fried.

### 6 AUCTIONEER

"Our niece at" a resort = AUCTIONEER: he sells lots.

### 7 GR-ANNIE

GR-ab the first two letters (GR) to the Little Orphan (ANNIE) = GRANNIE: with grandad.

### 8 RABBLE-ROUSERS

They stir up "us real robbers" = RABBLE ROUSERS: yes, they do stir up.

### 9 ADVENT-URESOME

The weeks before Christmas (ADVENT) get "Sue more" crazy (URESOME) = ADVENTURESOME: and daring.

### 14 P(I'LL)OW-CASE

Into the lawsuit about the captured soldier (P-OW CASE) I will get (I'LL) = PILLOWCASE: you sleep on it.

### 17 EUROS-TA-R

The new money (EUROS) thanks (TA) to the right (R) = EUROSTAR: goes very quickly.

### 19 FROG-MAN

Kissed by a Grimm ("grim" I hear) princess (FROG PRINCE) perhaps = FROGMAN: a swimmer.

### 21 EDITION

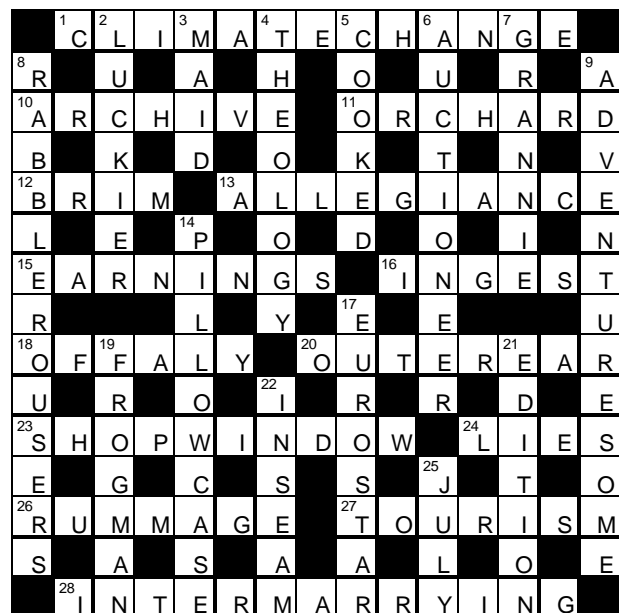
A printing is an EDITION, and a newspaper might publish a "late" EDITION.

The online message (I-M) about the North Sea (N-SEA) = INSEAM: leg length.
