1 HEAD-LAMPS

20 CHE(DDA)R

Sonny's partner, she was (CHE-R) taking in "Dad" upset (DDA) = CHEDDAR: the big cheese.

21 SU-E

To America, 'US', back (SU) east (E) = SUE: bring a suit.

23 T(EASE)D

A politician (T-D) about "freedom from labour" (EASE) = TEASED: provoked.

27 FINA(N-CIA)L

The final (FINA-L) infiltrated by "northern spies" (N-CIA) = FINANCIAL: concerned with money.

28 IN TOTO

At home (IN) with "Dorothy's dog" (in Oz) (TOTO) it's = IN TOTO: entirely.

29 B(OTTOMS) UP

In "the back of the pub" (B-UP) the new "mottos" (OTTOMS) for = BOTTOMS UP: cheers.

30 ERR-AND

Make a mistake (ERR) and (AND) = ERRAND: you might run one.

31 E(MBROIDE)R

Into "the Queen" (E-R) get the "bromide" mixture (MBROIDE) = EMBROIDER: use a needle.

2 EAR(WIG)

Exotic "gear" that (EAR-G) captured "the West Indies" (WI) = EARWIG: insect.

3 D-ANGLE

500 (D) there, between the two lines (ANGLE) = DANGLE: hang.

4 ARROWS

5 P(LAST)IC

In "the picture" (P-IC) "last" seen (LAST) = PLASTIC: credit cards.

6 UN(C/O-VER)ED

In the "nude" absurdly (UN-ED) [care of (C/O) a Reverend, 'Rev', up there (VER)] = UNCOVERED: naked.

7 SHIPLOADS

"Di's post LA" resort, for = SHIPLOADS: lots of cargo.

8 ASSYMETRY

"Yet my arms" flail about = ASSYMETRY: a lack of balance.

14 AB-STAINED

Jack (AB) and switched "instead" (STAINED) for = ABSTAINED: didn't vote.

15 O-L-FACTORY

Round (O) the Limerick (L) plant (FACTORY) = OLFACTORY: it's like the smell.

16 MA(NEAT-IN)G

In "a magazine" wrapper (MA-G) neat in (NEAT IN) is = MAN-EATING: like a tiger.

17 IT'S

Only even (letters) in "f-I-f-T-h-S", "s-I-x-T-h-S" or "n-I-n-T-h-S" (ITS) = IT'S: it is.

18 ICE

Kill (ICE) for "diamonds" (ICE).

22 UNI-FORM

This "university" (UNI) paperwork (FORM) = UNIFORM: it's worn.

24 PAT-TER

More like "Patrick"? (PAT-ER) sounds = PATTERN: that meaningless chatter.

25 SCAM-PI

It's "a swindle" (SCAM) 22/7 (PI) for = SCAMPI: seafood.

26 MANURE

Listen: "man, you're" = MANURE: a bit of a stinker!

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
