Guess what I did this week at work? Did you guess: wrote advertising statements for the standard IT jobs that cover the positions on my team?

People serving in my group have lots of different roles. These seven standard jobs are the starting place for creating each role.

Writing advertising statements is mainly about recruiting new people to file roles. – I have some needs there: currently vacant positions I'd be thrilled to see God fill with the people He's preparing for those roles—

Writing these advertising statements was also a powerful reminder of the provision of God: for all the amazing and talented people currently filling roles on my team.

Reading them again was another reminder of the privilege you and I have to be involved in this work. For instance, "*Is this the role for you to play in God's plan for the nations?*" Why yes, yes, it is.

Thanks for your role in the work of Bible translation and in the lives of each member of my team as you've prayed for, provided advice and counsel and supported me ...and them.

Cool Bible translation work (this work where we get to be involved)

Moise Yonta joyfully read aloud a Scripture portion on his smartphone, punctuating the phrases with vigorous gestures. This was God's Word in his mother tongue —the Ngiemboon language of Cameroon— and he was seeing it on his phone for the first time! As he came to the end of the selection, he jumped up and delightedly shook hands with a colleague. With a huge grin, he exclaimed, "Wonderful! Wonderful!"

It was indeed wonderful! Moise was the coordinator for the Ngiemboon translation project. Moise is one of more than 650 million cell phone subscribers in Africa, where cell phone service is far more available than landlines. While cell phones are used worldwide for communications, financial transactions, healthcare, and much more, we believe that God also intended this technology to support the distribution of His Word.

You may have heard about the Every Tribe Every Nation (ETEN) alliance. ETEN brings together philanthropic investors/donors and three Bible agencies —the American Bible Society, Biblica, and Wycliffe. ETEN's vision is to eradicate Bible poverty worldwide in this generation. Its primary focus is the development of the Digital Bible Library (DBL). The DBL currently holds over 600 texts including the Ngiemboon Bible that Moise reads— all standardized for easy downloading and secured against improper use or corruption. Wycliffe has contributed more than 290 texts so far and many more are on the way.
