



# **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)**

## **between**

## **THE COLLEGE OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS**

## **and**

## **JO-JIKUM**

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING dated **February 7, 2020** is between the COLLEGE OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS (CMI) P.O. Box 1258, Majuro, MH 96960 and Jo-Jikum at Bar Kan weto P.O. Box 1646, and is established for the use of the College's facilities and financial services and Jo-Jikum's expertise in selected areas.

### **The Parties agree as follows:**

#### **The College of the Marshall Islands shall provide to the Jo-Jikum the following services and equipment:**

- The use of selected, additional facilities and equipment as approved by CMI and subject to the policies and approval processes regarding the use of such facilities and equipment.
- Mentorship and guidance in relation to fiscal management after mutual consensus on the services and arrangements required.

#### **Jo-Jikum will provide to CMI:**

- An environmental issues and climate change workshop or seminar for CMI students at least once a semester
- A poetry workshop in Marshallese and English for CMI students at least once a semester.

### **Modifications and amendments**

This MOU may be varied and/or amended by the mutual agreement of the Parties and any such variation shall be set out in writing and signed by the Parties.



### Settlement of disputes

Any dispute arising out of the interpretation and implementation of this MOU shall be settled amicably in good faith through consultation or negotiation between the Parties without reference to any third party or any international tribunal.

### Legal effect


The Parties acknowledge that this MOU is not legally enforceable, but that it does not diminish the intention of the Parties to comply with the terms, conditions, responsibilities and undertakings stipulated in this MOU.

### Termination

Either party may terminate this MOU upon giving the other party six (6) months' notice in writing of its intention to do so. In the event of termination, both Parties agree to protect the interests of staff and students currently participating in collaborative programs or initiatives and to provide support necessary to enable them to conclude those initiatives successfully.
