1. Call to Order

- a. Welcome to all members

2. Special/Urgent Business

- a. Nomination and Vote of new Faculty Senate Executive Officers and Faculty Representatives in the various committees (Fall 2020 – Fall 2021). Officers serve for one academic year.
 - i. President – Moarieta lentaake wishes not to continue;
 - Nominations: Michael Young but rescinded his nomination; Adedayo Ogunmokun – willing to serve; Andrea Hazzard but declined nomination
 - Final nomination: Adedayo Ogunmokun, unanimously voted in as the President of the Faculty Senate
 - ii. Vice-President – Michael Young – rescinded his nomination
 - Nominations: Waisiki Baleikorocau but declined nomination; Alvin Page – willing to serve
 - Alvin Page was unanimously voted in as Vice-President
 - iii. Secretary/Treasurer –
 - Ana Bulavakarua wishes not to continue
 - Alexander Velasquez nominated, unanimously voted in as Secretary/Treasurer
 - iv. HR Committee –
 - Meitaka Kendall-Lekka is willing to continue; Marson Ralpho nominated. Both were unanimously voted in. Our gratitude goes to Nik Willson for stepping in when Jordan Prokosch had left
 - v. Enrollment and Management(?) Committee – Jennifer Seru and Oyinade Ogunmokun are willing to continue and were unanimously voted in. Jennifer reminded the Senate that the EMC's by-laws state that the representatives have to be department chairs, one of them has to be the Dev Ed Chair.
