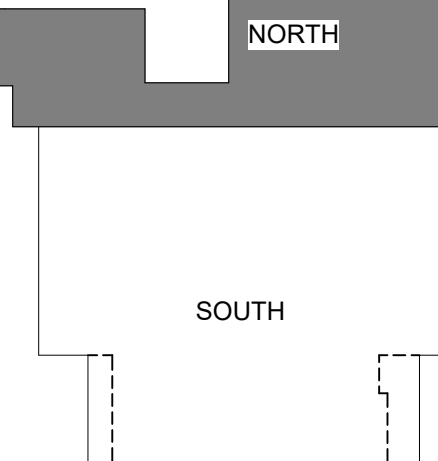
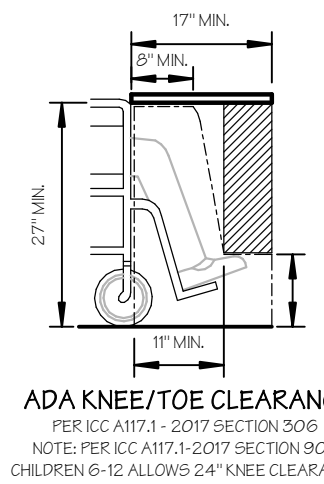
GENERAL FURNITURE NOTES

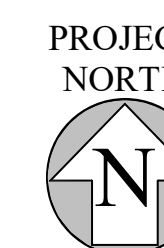
