The plans for the above referenced food facility have been approved. You may not deviate from the approved plans without written approval from this office. You should contact the local health department and building permits to make sure that you comply with all local requirements. Approval of these plans and specifications by this Office does not indicate compliance with any other code, law or regulation that may be required whether federal, state or local. A pre-opening inspection of the establishment with the equipment will be necessary to determine if it complies with the local and state laws governing food service facilities. As construction nears completion you must contact our office at 410-767-8400 to arrange for a pre-opening inspection. The health approval for use of the facility will be issued only after inspection confirms that the facility conforms to the approved plans and COMAR 10.15.03. Therefore, you must allow sufficient time for the initial, as well as any re-inspections. A set of plans bearing the stamped approval of the Office of Food Protection, Center for Facility and Process Review, State of Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, must be kept at the construction site during all stages of construction and be accessible during the pre-opening inspection. The pre-opening inspection will not be conducted if the plans are not available to the sanitarian. If you have any questions please call this office at 410-767-8412.
