



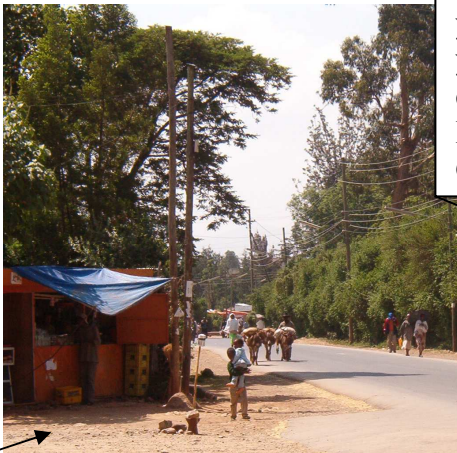
HOWe THINGS ARE... Addis Ababa, Ethiopia
